# *It's Write at Waddesdon Manor !*

## English Language Creative Writing workshops for Key Stages 3 to 5

This **NEW** Secondary Schools' workshop at Waddesdon Manor offers the fantastic opportunity to discover a world of treasures to inspire your pupils' creative writing. Work with one of our professional authors to gather ideas and to research through studying historical objects and works of art. Pupils will learn how to use sources for their writing other than books and the internet.

Topics available:

- **Writing to inform** – An alternative guide to the artworks at Waddesdon
- **Dramatic monologues** with some of the theatrical characters from the collection's portraits. (Key Stage 5)

Waddesdon Manor is a partner in the Wallace Collection's Regional Partnerships' Programme (The Museum Network). This workshop has been developed through this partnership and as a result of the hugely successful creative writing sessions at the Wallace Collection. *"Some Students wouldn't even attempt a creative writing task prior to this experience. The workshop will provide students with the opportunity to work with a professional author for 4 hours (2 hours in the morning and 2 hours in the afternoon) in the galleries and grounds on creative writing activities inspired by the works of art and objects in the collection.

<b>Key Stages 3 to 5</b>	Creative Writing workshops at Waddesdon Manor are available on Mondays or Tuesdays in September and October 2010. <b>Maximum group size 20.</b>	Waddesdon Visit - Free for schools with National Trust membership. Cost for non-member schools £2 per child.
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Each class will receive a CD containing images of Waddesdon Manor's works of art used in the session and useful information for follow up activities.
